

LifeSmarts U Health and Safety Lesson Apartment Safety: Checking It Out ACTIVITY KEY

Moving away from home and into an apartment is exciting and a big step to becoming a responsible adult. This independence calls for applying real-life knowledge about safety and security to choosing a safe, secure first apartment. Before signing a rental agreement, it is important to check for safety and security in the surrounding area, the apartment building, and the apartment itself.

The Grounds and Common Areas

Example: SECURITY CAMERAS in strategic locations. Also, ask if they are live and how long the recordings are saved

2	SECURITY LIGHTING in the parking area that illuminates the entire lot
3	LOCKS on shared facilities such as the laundry room or workout area
4	MAIL and package delivery are secure spaces
5	STORAGE areas have adequate lighting, are secured by lock and key
6	PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION is a short and safe walk from the apartment

The Apartment

Example: CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS since CO cannot be seen, smelled, or tasted CO, it is important to have a warning system

1	CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS since CO cannot be seen, smelled, or tasted CO, it is important to have a warning system
2	DEAD BOLT LOCKS on the doors of the apartment provide the best security
3	WINDOW LOCKS should be operational on all windows, and included in the fire escape plan
4	SECURITY BARS on sliding glass doors provide and extra measure of personal safety
5	PEEPHOLE in the front door allows the occupant to view persons knocking at the door

6	SMOKE DETECTORS inside every bedroom and outside of every sleeping area
7	TWO EXITS FROM EVERY ROOM are part of every fire escape plan; evaluate the potential for escape from your apartment
8	FIRE EXTINGUISHER an all-purpose extinguisher should be mounted close to an exit
9	FUSE BOX that is easily accessible and clearly labeled
10	ELECTRICAL OUTLETS should be adequate for use in every room, this helps avoid or minimize the use of extension cords
