4 minutes	Introductions Opening Questions to the participants	Prompts to introduce the team: What is a LifeSmarts Privacy and Security mentor? Who are we? Say something fun about yourselves to relax your audience or tell a social media story. What are the differences between private and secret? Is private information always secret?	
	1. Content Vocabulary, JV	Distribute or post the Basic Content Vocabulary List. Prompt: Today we are going to review and learn some terms that you should know if you use social media.	

		Give a few minutes for participants to read the list, then briefly describe the terms, adding examples that are common for their age group.

	Video: "Your Digital Footprint"	<p>Prompt: When you use social media it is your job to manage and care for your digital identity. This short video talks about being careful about what you share online.</p>	Video URL:
